► TO DO POLITICS DIFFERENTLY IN NICE

1. With an ethical public team : all members pledge not to consider politics as a trade and will unveil their income and patrimony at the beginning and at the end of their mandate.
2. With a committed public team : all members, elected or not, pledge to work together for the duration of their mandate on the charter guiding principles and on the absolute obedience to the rule of no mandates accumulation
3. By bringing back together elected politicians and citizens through the development of direct and participative procedures.
4. By using and valorizing the expertise of the public staff, which is a fundamental interface between the elected politicians and the citizens in order to make a success of any policy and any project.
5. By really developing community facilities (for young children as well as seniors) and really improving the living conditions (cleanliness, public safety...) of every district.
6. By returning the CANCA (Communauté d'Agglomération Nice Côte d'Azur) into the democratic fields through the active participation of citizens and Opposition.

7. With a project that links every solidarity (social, geographic, between generations).
8. With a project than takes into account every element of Sustainable Development. (environmental excellence as well as social cohesion and economical progress).
9. With a project that makes the reparation of the housing crisis its priority thanks to a voluntarist public action.
10. With a project that makes the city of Nice a real University and not simply a town with a university in its area.
11. With a project that renews cultural policies by privileging education (scholastic, popular, artistic)
12. With a project that starts a real policy of sports with educational goals by favouring the development of clubs and by helping the volunteers who manage those.
